

## **Game Coordinator (GC):**

- 1) Must be an adult (neutral party) **NO EXPERIENCE NECESSARY!!!!**
- 2) Must be present for the entire game (**sit on the field in a chair**, or if they have umpire experience take 3rd base, or any open base) - we have extra umpire shirts in the knaack box
- 3) Must check in with the umpires as they will report the name of the GC to me
- 4) Must sign the score book (no particular spot, just somewhere on the score sheet)
- 5) They are there to be sure the umpires are treated with respect by both coaches & parents
- 6) They should be part of the plate meeting with the umpires & managers (they should introduce themselves as the GC) - this way the teams know there is a 3rd party adult watching
- 7) They are there to help interpret rule questions if needed (keep the peace)
- 8) Coaches & Managers cannot question judgment calls by umpires (strikes, balls, fair, foul, out & safe), they can only question rule interpretations.

**\*\*Please remember, games cannot be played without a GC present when there are only youth umpires doing the game\*\***
